Information about the town and/or neighborhood	Guadix lies in southern Spain, in the Autonomous Region of Andalusia, about 100km from the coast of the Mediterranean. Getting to school	Guadix itself, being a small town, is easy to get around. The route between Granada and Guadix is currently operated by the Bam company: https://www.busbam.com/ It is normally possible to commute with one of the teachers' carpools, in which case you would be charged roughly the price of the bus fare.
Accommodation	Both Guadix and Granada have a vibrant home rental market. with properties in Guadix normally available in the vicinity of the school and an abundance of rental housing in Granada.
